You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

1) The number of times an arterial tourniquet or haemostatic pressure dressing was been used by your services between 1st June 2016 and 31st May 2017.

Please note that the data shown below is based on a 6-month period as to validate more than this would exceed the timeframes set out in Section 12. This information has been obtained through manually reviewing our database and is only an indicative figure. All PCR's are scanned and the analysis is based on completion of a relevant field within the form.
