You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

I am requesting a freedom of information request in regards to head injuries and the worsening care advice (WCA) given.

How many head injuries have been sustained in 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017? Of these, how many were conveyed to hospital for further investigation and how many were left at home with WCA?

Please see table below showing the amount of incidents that had 'Head' in the free text (but excluding 'headache' and 'head ache'). Please note that there may be more than one patient at an incident.
