I wish to know how much your trust has spent on specialist equipment for bariatric patients (patients over 160kg) during the last three years? Total spend over the past 3 years is £30,734.12

Please give a breakdown of the type of specialist bariatric equipment used by the trust and the amounts spent, split between Rental Expenditure and Purchased Equipment? All items in use are purchased. Equipment by type is:-

- Bariatric Trolley bed -£13,000
- Bariatric stair climber £4,500
- Mobile Hoist £5,000
- Barikit £300
- Hoverjack £3,300

If equipment used is on a Rental basis, please specify if this was under a contract basis or ad hoc?
