2 Can you provide me with a breakdown of what Equipment they carry? By Volunteer First Responders I am referring to Ambulance/Community First Responder Currently we have two tiers of CFR Responders

Basic life support and choking protocol is part of basic training for both courses for adult and paediatrics

ECHO – Able to attend C1 calls for cardiac arrest, choking. Equipment: AED O2 only to be used at 15ltrs per minute Pocket mask for ventilations supported with O2 Standard PPI (Gloves, mask, etc.) Mobile phone for communication id High viz over cover

<u>MIKE</u> – Full CFR plus modules to allow them to attend most categories of calls Additional three-day course including Medical condition, O2 therapy observations NEWs scoring, History taking, pain scoring, wound dressing, burns, Salbutamol, Aspirin, BVM adult and child, airway management. PCR completion, bleeding, fractures.

Equipment: CFR bag AED O2 OP airways Dressings



BVM Pocket masks Phone PCRs
