I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/18/02/24.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

I write in respect on the new ARP 2.3 programme which has now been adopted by all Ambulance NHS Trusts.

NHS England states that Category 3 details are labelled "Urgent" with an arrival standard of 120 minutes that should be met 90% of the time.

In view of that can you inform as to how you believe that that standard should be met. By either:

- Emergency response using exemptions?
- Immediate response without exemption usage?
- Urgent response without exemption usage?
- Other? Please give details.

## Is that position:

- For the driver to determine?
- Trust Policy?
- Trust advisory position?
- Other? Please give details.

SECAmb staff have been issued with guidance around the expectations of how they should respond to various categories under ARP (please find this attached).

Page 7 explains 'All C1, C2 and C3 incidents must be responded to on blue lights regardless of the time of call'.
