I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/18/04/24.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

**1. How many active (non-expired) risk flags the trust/service had against addresses for the reason of warning of potential risks of violence at the latest date for which figures are readily available.**

We currently have 43 red marks (figures as of 19<sup>th</sup> April)

A red marker relates to the highest risk category and is defined as those addresses where information available makes it clear that staff have been physically assaulted or threatened with violence.

**2. Please can you also inform me:**

**(i) How many employees of the trust/service were, to the employer's knowledge, diagnosed with Post-Traumatic Stress disorder in each year 2015/16, 2016/17, and 2017/18; and**

Unfortunately, we do not hold this information. This is held with occupational health as all referrals are confidential.

**(ii) Whether the trust/service currently funds the training of its staff in the Trauma Risk Management (TRiM) system, and if not, whether it plans to do so.**

Yes, we fund training of TRiM Practitioners and have trained approx. 140 staff. We have also trained 4 Trainers and 15 Coordinators.
