GUIDANCE:

By emergency 999 calls, I mean any call, answered by a call handler at your control room, regardless of whether this was forwarded from 111 or a GP

Question 1:

Please provide the number of calls received monthly since December 2015 - March 2018 in relation to a rough sleeper (homelessness) concern or injury for the entire City of Brighton and Hove.

Please note: I am NOT expecting any personal information such as phone numbers, names or locations. Please also state how many times a crew was dispatched and how many times the patient was taken to hospital.

Please note this may not be a true reflection of calls as there may be cases where this term is mentioned within the text but does not relate to the incident itself and may relate to something else i.e. patient's medical history. There may also be cases where the patient is homeless but this is not mentioned by the caller and therefore not documented in the notes.

Please note that the Trust introduced a new CAD system in July 2017. This will have contributed to the sharp rise in incidents recorded from this date.
