I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/18/04/23.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

Under the Freedom of Information Act, could you provide me with a database extract for the period from July 1, 2017 to March 31, 2018 with data for every ambulance handover, containing columns for A&E department where handover took place, date or month, notification time or time ambulance arrived at A&E, time handover took place/handover time/tunaround time, what level of call the ambulance was on (e.g. Red 1, Category 1 etc.). Please find this attached.

Please note that the problem nature is determined by the call taker, and not a diagnosis, what was found when a crew arrived on scene or what the patient was treated for if conveyed to hospital.

Please note some incidents may start at a lower priority. However, due to the length of response delay, these may be upgraded to a higher priority to ensure a quicker response to the patient. Due to reporting requirements, some of these incidents may be reported against the higher priority and not the original priority given
