I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/18/11/28.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

1) How many 'bagging' or 'dinking' instances your ambulance service has seen for children (under 18's) in the past five years. (This often relates to gang-linked violence, whereby a victim is intentionally stabbed/maimed/assaulted in the rectum or groin area to keep them off the streets.)

We do not have a specific way of recording these types of incidents should they arise. We have done a free text search for 'bagging' and 'dinking' which has returned no results. Please note this may not be a true reflection of calls as there may be cases where these terms have not been mentioned on the initial call and is therefore not documented within the notes.

- 2) I would also like to know how many children you treated were male/female/transgender. N/A
- 3) Please also explain what 'weapons' were used to assault the child. I would like this information presented in a general list form.

Please present all this information simply and clearly, for example:

2013: XXX instances involving children. XXX children were male. XXX children were female. XXX children were transgender. 'Weapons' used include knives, screwdrivers and spoons. N/A
