You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

This is an updated request to the one that I submitted in December 2016 - under the freedom of information act for the following details:

For the calendar years 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 to date (broken down by each year) How many times have South East Coast Ambulances or staff been sent to assist with the discovery of suspected illegal immigrants?

This data has been obtained using a free text search for the word 'immigrant'.

Please note this may not be a true reflection of calls as there may be cases where this term is mentioned within the text but does not relate to the incident itself and may relate to something else i.e. patient's medical history. There may also be cases where this has not been mentioned on the initial call and is therefore not documented within the notes
