I am writing in response to your enquiry under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) reference FOI/18/12/33.

You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

1: What funds have been externally provided to develop to the clinical work force and how have those funds been used in detail.

Funds that have been externally provided to develop to the clinical work force for the past 24 Months (October 2017 to September 2019) was £4,822,621 used as follows:

Developing in-service Paramedics	£3,015,570
Supporting External Students with Placements at	
SECAmb	£955,169
Paramedic Upskilling	£614,875
Clinical Assessment Service Development	£83,300
Simulation Training	£153,707
Total	£4,822,621

2: How much was spent on producing and purchasing each of the 7 values cubes used by the trust, (cost of each cube) £168 per cube

3: How much did the recent and well publicised recruitment trip to Dubai cost (full cost break down of all SECAmb and Non- SECAmb staff).

Five Secamb staff travelled to Dubai and this cost the Trust £20,097. 'This includes airport transfers and transport to recruitment events for all staff (£704), the cost of the recruitment stands at the event (£12,510), expenses claimed (£371), £2,055 for flights and £4,457 for hotel accommodation.
