the number of patients you treated who had been stabbed who were under the age of 18 in 2016, 2017 and 2018?

This data has been obtained using the following problem natures:

- Stabbing
- Stabbing (Central)
- Stabbing (Peripheral)

Please note that the problem nature is determined by the call taker, and not a diagnosis, what was found when a crew arrived on scene or what the patient was treated for if conveyed to hospital.



^{**}Prior to the introduction of ARP, we only had a problem nature for 'shot/stabbing' so we are unable to differentiate how many of these related solely to stabbings or knife attacks
