You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

1) please can you send me a copy of the current subject access request acknowledgment AND response letter that you use

Subject Access Requests are dealt with by 3 different departments:-

- Legal please find attached response letter, there is no standard acknowledgement letter.
- Patient Experience Team (PET) please find attached copy of acknowledgement letter. Each response is different so there is no standard reply
- HR Please find attached copy of acknowledgement and response letter

2) a copy of the last 5 dpias completed

Please find attached a blank copy of our DPIA template which is in line with ICO guidelines

3) a copy of any internal mandatory information governance training that you give to staff which was written in the last 2 years including presentation slides and videos and any other media

We have a bespoke information governance training package online which has been developed in house and is therefore exempt under section 43

4) a copy of any instructions given to staff members to reduce data security breaches, for example double checking work which was written in the last 5 years
