You requested the following information, please also see our response below:

1) Do all frontline clinicians have immediate access to nasal ETC02 monitoring for spontaneously breathing patients?

Yes, they do for adults but we do not have this capability for children

2) If yes, in what year was this equipment rolled out trust wide? In 2008 the Trust rolled out EMMA Capnography devices to monitor ETCO2, nasal ETCO2 was rolled out during 2017.
