If possible, with dates, and broken down into years, and the locations - how many were at the junction with Cooden Drive, Richmond Avenue and Westcourt Drive.

If figures are not available this far back, please let me have figures for the years available

The postcode for the crossroad junction of Cooden Drive, Richmond Avenue and Westcourt Drive is TN39 3AX.

The rest of Cooden Drive is TN39 3AA, TN39 3AB, TN39 3AE, TN39 3AH, TN39 3AJ, TN39 3AL, TN39 3AN, TN39 3AS, TN39 3AT, TN39 3AX, TN39 3AY, TN39 3DB, TN39 3DD, TN39 3DF, TN39 3DG, TN39 3DH, TN39 3DL, TN39 3DQ.

- Due to the format that the data was stored we are unable to provide number of RTCs that were reported to the police.
- We are only able to provide number of RTC incidents at the requested locations.
- Road Traffic accidents has been identified on pathways with the following pathway options: RTC, RTC - Difficult Access, RTC – Entrapment, RTC - Moderate/Major Injury, RTC - No/Minor Injury, RTC - Roll Over, RTC - Service Vehicle Involved, RTC - Unconscious/Arrest, RTC - Unconscious/Arrest, RTC 1st/2nd Party and RTC 3rd/4th Party.
- Please note that not every incident will be identified if this has not been recorded in one of the following categories.

- Please note that the locations were identified using the postcodes provided. Not every incident will be identified if this has not been recorded and not every incident will be directly related to the postcodes e.g. an RTC across the road from postcode 'TN39 xxx'.
- Values provided are from 2011 onwards as this is the data available.
- We are unable to provide dates and locations as this is too identifiable.
- Please note that that for figures that are less than 10 we are unable to provide the exact number as it may be identifiable to individuals.
